

Flachau: enjoy winter to the full

All of those for whom skiing and winter sports on glorious white powder snow mean the world will feel at home in Flachau. Imagine it's a cool, sunny morning. You're standing at the top of the mountain and you adjust your helmet. The clear, fresh winter air blows around your face. Before you are the best-prepared ski slopes, and surrounding you, a gigantic mountain panorama. The fun is about to start ... These, yes, precisely these, are the moments that make up the "Skiing Lifestyle". And the enjoyment is great, as from December 2020, even more skiing fun is on offer in Flachau.

It was a vision for a long time, but from next season, it will be a reality: the new "Panorama Link" cable car which connects the skiing areas of Snow Space Salzburg Flachau, Wagrain, St. Johann with the Flachauwinkl-Kleinarl shuttle mountain and the Zauchensee skiing paradise.

It's all in the name

During a journey in the modern gondolas of the new Panorama Link, which are designed with lots of glass, over a length of 3.1 kilometres and with a journey time of 8 minutes, skiers and snowboarders can enjoy a breath-taking views of the Hohe and Niedere Tauern mountains. The new cable car therefore lives up to its name.

Flachau in the center of Ski amadé

12 peaks, 5 valleys and 210 km of downhill skiing runs offer endless possibilities for winter sports enthusiasts to enjoy the maximum of freedom.

From challenging World Cup slopes to any number of downhill runs and family pistes, through to international freestyle and freeride spots, skiing fans of all abilities are certain to find their perfect spot in the heart of the Ski amadé.

Winter sports enthusiasts appreciate the wide and perfectly-prepared carving pistes at the **Snow Space Salzburg – Flachau – Wagrain – St. Johann**. Modern snowmaking systems ensure an absolute certainty of snow, while comfortable lifts with weather protection covers ensure the maximum of comfort. The Snow Space Salzburg skiing area impresses with its perfectly prepared slopes, its excellent gastronomy and a gigantic mountain panorama with a view of the Dachstein and Tauern mountains. The



AUDI FIS Ski World Cup Ladies Night Slalom Flachau, which is held annually in January on the Hermann Maier World Cup course, is a genuine highlight.

The **Skiparadies Zauchensee** is a hot spot for ambitious, sporty skiers. This skiing area is also considered an insider's tip among free-riders and off-piste skiers, who appreciate untouched slopes and natural snow away from the best-prepared slopes. An additional fun factor is provided by numerous offers, such as photo points, 3 different Ski Movies routes and the Family Fun Park.

The **Shuttleberg Flachauwinkl – Kleinarl** is a playground for free-riders, free-skiers and snowboarders. The 160-metre-long Superpipe in Absolut Park has 5.6 meter high walls, and is used by pros and European national teams as a training area. "Burton – The Stash" can trace its history back to the snowboarding legends of Jake Burton and Craig Kelly: snow and wood play the leading roles in a huge backcountry area with some 80 obstacles. It is also ideal for beginners and children!

With the Fatbike, in the Lucky Flitzer and in the Looping slide

In addition to the wide range of skis, Flachau also offers numerous opportunities for trying out new things off-piste. The snow doesn't just mean skiing, though: the winter landscape around Flachau is great for exploring by Segway or Fatbike, for example. If those are too slow for you, get on a snow bike or a sledge: four illuminated toboggan runs promise every amount of fun on your sledge. The "Lucky Flitzer" Alpine rollercoaster takes you down into the valley at high speed – and also in the evening thanks to the floodlights. A snowshoe hike, by contrast, is a very romantic experience.

Those who have spent the whole day outdoors can look forward to warm moments of fun in the water: the nearby Therme Amadé, with eleven swimming pools, a spacious sauna area and several slides provides for every amount of fun as well as all-around relaxation.

Great food and drink

Love doesn't just depend on the right kind of food. Those who faithfully make their way down the slopes have certainly earned the right to enjoy delicacies such as Kasnocken dumplings, Apfelstrudel and Kaiserschmarren pancakes.

The gastronomy served in Flachau is characterised by its regional and seasonal character. The Flachau chefs create a very special "Total Lokal" dish each year.

For 2021, it will be ragout of Flachau beef in root juice with sage polenta and celery puree. This will be available on many menus in Flachau with the "Total Lokal" seal of approval. Be sure to give it a try!
